Some "Inn" - teresting facts about KHI

The Kintner House Inn was built at this site in 1873.

It had previously been located a block north of here and that building burned to the ground. Afterward, the KHI was relocated to its current site.

Before the fire, the KHI had 34 rooms.

The Kintners lived on the first floor and rented out the two top floor rooms.

John Hunt Morgan commandeered the KHI in 1893. They reenact this scene from history each year at the Battle of Corydon Reenactment.

A group of investors led by Mr. Blaine Wiseman purchased this building in 1984. It was restored in 1986, and the Kintner House Inn was reopened to visitors in January of 1987.

KHI is listed on the National Historical Registry.

Famous people who have stayed at the KHI include Corydon native, James Best (known as "Rosco" on Dukes of Hazard), Senator Richard Lugar, and Wilford Brimley.
